



Home Rehabilitation Program



GCRA is bringing housing rehabilitation opportunities to qualified low and moderate income homeowners throughout Greenville County.

About the Rehab Program

- The primary function of this income-eligible program is for needed home repairs and upgrades to be made affordable to low and moderate income citizens.
- Once the homeowner is qualified, according to program guidelines, staff will arrange for assessment of the home.
- Safety and soundness needs will be determined, and then the customer may request cosmetic home improvements where allowable.

The Process

WHO CAN QUALIFY?

- Working low to moderate income homeowners or homebuyers.
- Elderly, retired, or disabled adults.

HOW DO I PAY FOR THIS REHABILITATION?

- Once approved, the customer will be extended either a low interest (0-3%) loan or a possible 0% deferred (for as long as you live in the home) loan through the GCRA.

HOW DO I BEGIN?

- If you live in Greenville County and own or are buying your home, contact GCRA at 242-9801, extension 110.
- Staff will work with you to fill out an application for qualification.
- Once approved, the rehabilitation process will begin.
